PREPARE

- Know where to go in an emergency
- Know where emergency gear, first aid and supplies are stored
- Know your evacuation routes
- Be prepared to help others

PREVENT

- Know how to secure utilities, electric, water, gas
- Maintain access to exits and critical equipment
- Avoid storage in and around emergency equipment and lanes of egress
- Check emergency lighting and batteries
- Remove tripping hazards
- Properly store combustible/flammable materials

PLAN

- Ensure access to your emergency plan
- Know your resources; NOAA, FEMA, Red Cross, Ready.gov
- Train new employees and conduct drills at scheduled intervals
- Check your gear monthly
- Communicate hazards immediately

Do you have an employee with special needs?

- They may need extra assistance during evacuation
- Employees with medical conditions may need access to their medications

Team up with neighbors.

Responding to a crisis is a community affair, and communication is key. Neighbors may have extra storage above flood stage or extra fuel for a generator.
